Good News

The following "Good News" items were shared:

Reports

Mary Breyfogle, Elementary Principal & School Improvement Coordinator

Mrs. Breyfogle reviewed the elementary report cards that were recently distributed to students and parents. Teachers are now reporting on priority standards, using a scale from 0-4. Members of the SINA committee will attend a standards-based grading seminar and will communicate the information to all staff.

Thad Stanley, Secondary Assistant Principal

Mr. Stanley reported on the following items:

- Parent-Teacher conferences will be held on November 11th and 12th.
- The MS/HS is working on constructing a food pantry in conjunction with the Food Bank of Iowa to go along with the backpack program at the elementary.
- During the first term, Panorama had 68 students taking college level courses through a variety of available resources.
- An "Officer Friendly" program was done on October 30th at the elementary with Chief Reising handing out trick or treat bags to students.

Shawn Holloway, Superintendent

Mr. Holloway reported on the following items:

- Work continues on the marketing and branding of the district. Ann Appleseth will consult on big picture items, such as creating a universal logo while district staff will focus on more specific marketing strategies. Panorama staff members Vanessa Phillips and Adam Crannell have already spend significant time working on marketing the district. In addition, Kylee Boettcher will have students in her classroom working on brochures that highlight the district.
- Panorama has officially joined four other Iowa school districts in a lawsuit filed against Curriculum Loft who manufacturers the KUNOs tablets the school purchased for the 1:1 implementation.

Feasibility Study

Mr. Holloway reported that a feasibility study will be done by the lowa Department of Education to determine if a future partnership with Guthrie Center will be advantageous for the district. The board requested that this study include information for additional neighboring districts to determine what partnership would be most beneficial for Panorama. Those additional districts included Coon Rapids – Bayard, Perry and West Central Valley.
