- Panorama teams placed 8th and 15th out of 16 teams in the High School All Conference Academic Bowl.
- 62 students in PCSD and ACGC are taking DMACC concurrent enrollment courses in English Composition and Spanish Conversation this semester for a total of 194 college credit hours to be earned at no additional cost to students and their families.
- The High School Student Council had its 7th annual Spread the Word to End the Word Assembly Wednesday, March 6 as part of the global engagement campaign to increase inclusion amongst people with and without and developmental disabilities through grassroots action.
- Robyn Ploeger and Kylee Boettcher experienced three days of complete immersion in an out-of-this-world adventure at the Space Exploration Educator's Conference at the Johnson Space Center in Houston, TX. - Sharing Librarian with Earlham Joan would be at Earlham CSD 15 days a year. Earlham would pay per diem for Joan's services.
- Bagley Water Situation Panorama Secondary Building will be available during business hours for Bagley residents to fill water containers.
